Standard Varieties and Groups

This show will be conducted under the ANBC standard released on 01 January 2004.

Exhibits must conform to the standard for both the variety characteristics and colour. Those covered by the standard in sections 1 to 8, and the first 'Opaline' class (section 9) must be the standard primary variety without combination.

Those exhibits entered in the 'Opaline AOSV' class must be a combination of Opaline and any number of the varieties allowed to be grouped with Opaline in Section 9 of the standard.

Exhibits in classes represented in the standard in sections 10 to 16 and section 18 may be the primary variety only or any standard combination in their group.

Exhibits eligible for the 'Any Other Standard Variety' class are those set out in the standard for Section 17 (Saddleback, Dark Eyed Clear, Darkwing, Suffused Yellow/White).

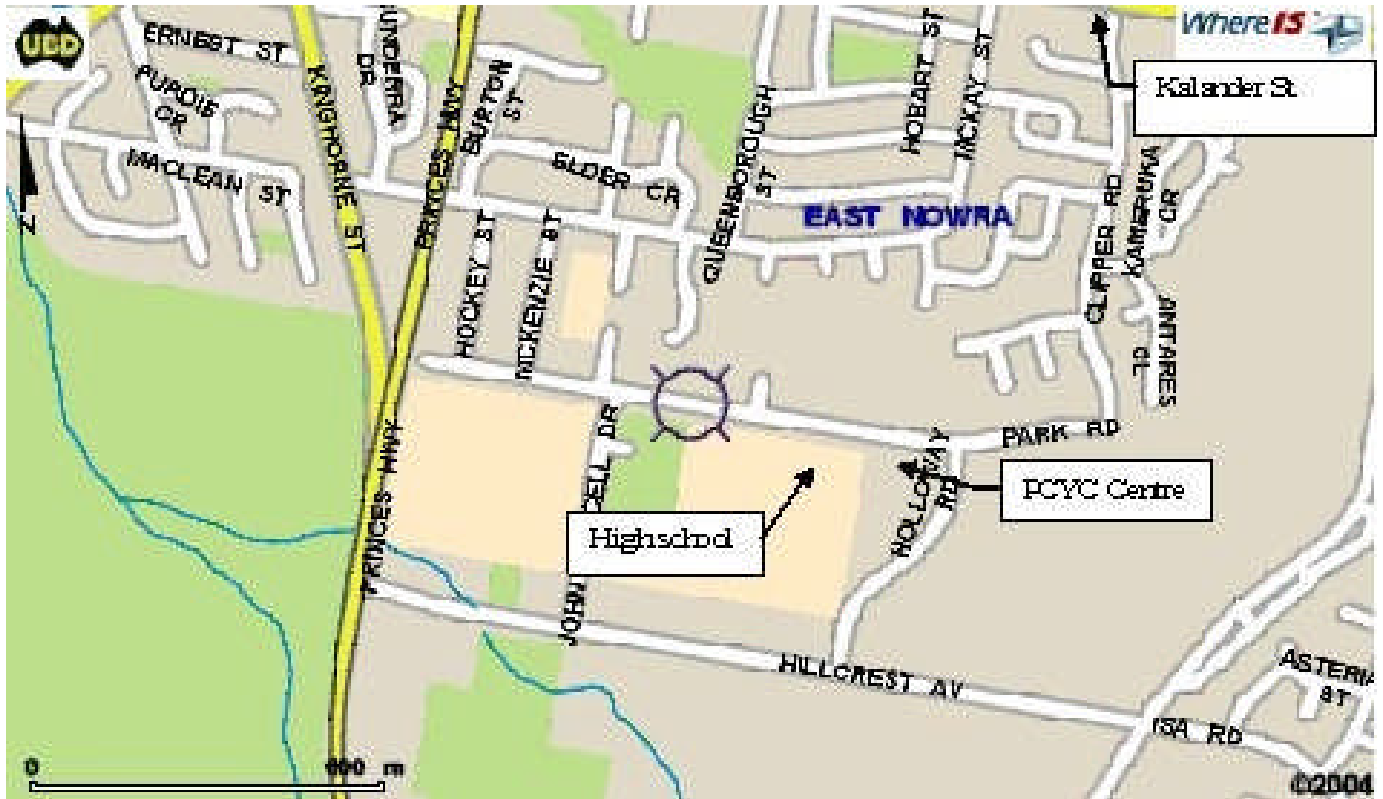
